



The Site: Location Former MOD Satcom Ground Radar Station at Balado Bridge Kinross



The Site: Former MOD Satcom Ground Radar Station at Balado Bridge Kinross









The site was part of the former RAF Balado Bridge site and runways, having been added to the south of the airfield in the 1980's when the Satcom Listening Station was opened.

The site is iconically known as 'The Golf Ball' and has enjoyed a visible status for many decades.


Alongside the Radome, there is an attached equipment building, a facilities building and guard gatehouse. There is also a 25m high communications tower and all set within a 9 acre site.

History


There is a historical, aligned fit to the end scheme and use for the site, which brings additional benefits. The site's history, in terms of alignment to flight with RAF Balado Bridge and more recently its use during cold war listening situations and monitoring of ICBM missiles, provides additional links to space and propulsion.
